Committee Reports:

Finance: Entire account: \$6132.83 Troop account: \$2438.53 (\$76.20 per Scout) Scout accounts: \$3694.30 Scout Store account: not provided Fertilizer = \$145.00 Boundary Waters = \$0.00 (payments made)

Secretary: Approval of the January committee meeting minutes was motioned by Pat, seconded by Mark, and approved unanimously by committee.

Fundraising: No update

Web Master: Pat commented that it is difficult to update the webpage. He will upload the latest Newsletter. Dawn will send items for Pat to add to the website.

New Scout Registration: Pack 87 will bridge 5 Cub Scouts on Saturday. Scott will prepare the Welcome packets, neckerchiefs and track registrations/transfers. Dawn and Scott wrote a Welcome Letter and Parent Information/Resources Survey to be included along with the Youth application and January Newsletter in the Welcome packet.

Eagle Coordinator: No update

Re-Charter: Final copy received from District; Dawn will schedule YPT with Fredie in February. **FOS:** Dawn will write letters and follow up on pledges to complete submission by end of February **Lawn Mowing:** No update

Old Business:

Youth Protection Training: If an Adult completes on-line training but is not a registered leader or committee member, training will be tracked in YPT system. Make two copies of certificate – one for personal files and one to troop. Please note -- no member ID number will be assigned and adult will not be listed on Troop re-charter. If the Adults would like to take YPT as a class, Dawn has the DVD and tests. Troop training will be discussed at a future committee meeting.

Future Dates reserved at Church: Dawn contacted Fredie, our church representative, to request June 4 or 18 for the garage sale and December 3 for the tree sale. Confirmation will be received by next committee meeting.

Adult Leader Registration: Tabled for further discussion within the policy subcommittee.

NTIER Update: Final NTIER payment of \$206 is due March 22. Airfare payment of \$269.40 is due May 31 + checked bag fees due at time of departure. Shuttle payment of \$135.21 is due May 31. John will be coordinating and tracking the registration and training requirements for all Adult Leaders. John asked that a Swimming away meeting be scheduled for late April or early May in order for all Scouts to work on Swimming merit badge and the basic swim test.

New Business:

New Scout registration fee: Discussion was held including: the scouting year runs from Jan 1 – Dec 31, scouts transferring from a Pack or another Troop pay a \$1 registration fee, new scouts pay a \$15 registration fee, Boy's Life subscriptions are pro-rated for the year. Pat motioned that all Scouts, new or transferring, will pay the fee.

The new Scout registration fee of \$15 will be paid when the Youth Application is submitted to Troop. The transferring registration fee of \$1 can be paid with submission of Youth Application or from funds in transferring Cub Scout Account or have a negative balance until funds are earned and deposited into Scout account. Scott seconded, and the committee approved unanimously.

Ben Francia's Scout Account: The Committee reviewed the account transaction and discussed Ben's account as well as a general policy. Scott motioned that the \$50 payment remain in the Troop Account as it was determined that this payment was the NTIER non-refundable down payment and the \$135 be refunded to the Francia's. Kim seconded and the committee approved unanimously. Dawn will send an email to Margaret and copy Carol so a check can be written and mailed.

Policy – Draft Version of how to distribute Scout Account funds when Scout quits:

1. Money transferred from a Cub Scout Account will stay in the Troop account.

2. Money in Scout account remains in the Troop account when the Scout leaves the Troop unless the parent/guardian petitions the committee, in person at a committee meeting.

3. After 2 consecutive re-charter years, the Scout and family lose the right to petition for refund of Scout Account.

4. Scout may purchase outdoor equipment and submit receipts to Treasurer for reimbursement.

The draft above will be further developed prior to adding to the policy document. The Policy subcommittee will write a policy for Scout Accounts when the scout ages out or earns Eagle rank. Also the subcommittee will discuss and develop a policy for using the forfeited funds to start a Troop scholarship fund.
