

SCOUTMASTER'S MINUTE



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Due to a schedule change from Council we will not be camping on the weekend of 13-15 April. Forestry day has been moved to 28 April, and since that is the weekend before Spring Camporee we will not be going. Instead we are planning a bike ride around Ft Collins on the 14th. Plan to meet at the CLP parking lot with your bike, helmet, water, and snacks at 9am. The ride should take about 2 hours and end back at CLP.

On the weekend of April 28/29 we have the Ft Collins Nursery fundraiser. Times are 9:30 am to 2:30 pm both days. Please be sure to sign up if you can make it. Fundraising is never fun, but it is an important element of keeping the Troop going, and it teaches the Scouts a good lesson in supporting themselves. Spring Camporee will be May 4-6 at BDSR. The Theme will be Survivor Soaring Eagle Challenge:

 Join us on May 4, 5, & 6 for a fun filled weekend of at a Spring camporee modeled after the Survivor TV Show. You will be dropped off on the Soaring Eagle Island where you will be divided into Tribes. You will travel around the Island with another Tribe competing in many activities earning points that will earn you special rewards at Saturday night's Tribal Council. Get ready to Outwit, Outplay and Outlast the other Tribes to earn the title of Ultimate Survivor.

Sign-up sheet is available now. Cost will be \$24 per Scout and \$5 per adult.

While we continue to schedule and work on new merit badges, lots of Scouts have unfinished ones and we are going to start pushing hard to get those completed. So, all Scouts, look through your blue cards and merit badge work books and bring the incomplete ones in to get a plan for finishing them. If you are unsure what you might have incomplete then see Mr. Powers.

Summer Camp will be here in no time. Final payments have been collected and mailed in. We are currently booked for 24 Scouts and 7 adults for the week of July 8-14 at Medicine Mountain Scout Ranch in South Dakota. We are able to accommodate additional Scouts or adults if someone still wants to attend. We will be setting up our side trips for the Wednesday of that week so be sure to get your input to me. A very important item is physicals. Every summer camp participant needs a current BSA physical to attend camp. The forms can be downloaded from the Longs Peak Council website. Any camper without a current physical in hand will be sent home from camp on check-in day so please get those physicals done and turned in to me.

Finally a note about adult participation. While we strive to have a boy led Troop, we cannot go on campouts without adequate adult supervision. That means two deep adults at a minimum. On the March and April campouts we had a hard time finding a second adult. Parents, please participate when you can. If everyone takes a turn it is not so time consuming. If the same few parents come every time it gets to be a burden. Adults attending summer camp will need to complete or update their Youth Protection Guidelines training to be sure you are current. This can be done online through the Longs Peak Council website. A BSA membership number is not needed for YPG training.

*Participation in Fundraising: Discussion of instituting fees or requiring participation in fundraising for Troop expenses and research into how other troops handle this issue. Tom Noon suggested that there needs to be "buy in" from Scouts, and fundraisers must be scheduled 6-12 months in advance. Also, there is a new policy that allows troops to establish participation expectations for advancement. This is meant to encourage leadership and participation. John suggested that patrol leaders should email patrols regarding participation in fundraisers, account balances should be posted regularly and that during the meeting on April 17th, time should be devoted to meeting with patrol leaders for a discussion about how they want to handle fundraising and improve participation. The hope is that all Scouts will participate instead of the same Scouts volunteering every time there is a work day at the Elk's Lodge or fundraiser at Fort Collins Nursery, to name a couple of examples.
