Committee Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month during the Scout meeting. All parents should strive to attend, as this is a great opportunity to participate in the Troop and keep abreast of Troop plans and activities. *Please join us for our next Committee Meeting: Tuesday, December 4, 2012.*

Minutes from 6 November, 2012 Troop 87 committee meeting

- I. Minutes of previous meeting were approved by voice vote.
- A. **Finance**: Treasurer reported balances as follows:
 - a. Entire account = 3032.42
 - b. Troop account = 1507.37
 - c. Scout accounts = 1525.05
- B. MBU cost to be \$23/scout.
- C. Treasurer to email scouts whose accounts are in arrears.
- II. **Popcorn**; Cindy Tunney reported on popcorn sales: \$1922 sold, resulting in the scouts commission of 634.26. A motion by Scott Addington to explore new fund-raising strategies, seconded by Doug Burdett, was approved. Payment for popcorn is due to Cindy Tunney by 4 December. Mr Noon stated that the popcorn sales are the only BSA fundraiser.
- III. **Tree cutting**; Scott Addington reported:
 - a. Tree cutting is scheduled for 24 November in Beaver Meadows.
 - b. Target is to cut 40 to 50 trees for the sale.
 - c. Ms Dorsch emphasized the need to fill out a tour plan for drivers, scouts.
 - d. The need to wear cold weather gear was also stressed.
 - e. Committee to post tree sale flyers around town.
- IV. **Leadership positions**; Troop to conduct election 13 November to fill the vacated positions of bugler and patrol leader. Senior Patrol Leader is to appoint scribe and quartermaster positions (i.e. not elected positions).
- V. BDSR is the **summer camp** choice, per troop vote, for 2013.
- VI. Items requiring action
 - a. Eagle project process, discussion with Tom Noon.
 - b. High adventure camp, to discuss options.
 - c. Re-charter; Ms Dorsch is processing the paperwork, and will contact all inactive scouts.
 - d. Troop experienced a net loss of 5 scouts for 2012.
 - e. The ongoing need for Youth Protection Training was discussed. Items of concern: Weather training, first aid, Outdoor First Aid requires a 2-weekend committment. Matt Condell is to check the adult leaders status.
- VII. Eagle board project is on hold, pending a list of Troop 87 Eagle Scouts from council.

VIII. BSA Participation Rules

- a. Doug Burdett summarized these, and discussion ensued with Mr Noon providing guidance and clarifying BSA policies where necessary.
- b. "Active" scout means: registered, active, no disciplinary actions against the scout, and meet the unit's criteria for reasonable participation.
- c. Scott Addington moved to revisit 1) elected versus appointed positions; 2) participation; by the December meeting.
- d. Mr Noon clarified that outside positions, while commendable, do not count towards BSA rank advancement.
