Committee Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month during the Scout meeting. All parents should strive to attend, as this is a great opportunity to participate in the Troop and keep abreast of Troop plans and activities. *Please join us for our next Committee Meeting.*

Troop 87 minutes, 5 February

Dawn Dorsch opened the meeting.

- I. Treasurer reported #3,082.61 total in the troop account. Scout funds work out to \$130/scout, or \$74/scout excluding funds from the retired scouts.
- II. Second item of business was the Job Descriptions, as written by Doug Burdette with considerable input from Lee Roberts and Pat Knebel. Kim Yung made a motion to accept the Job Descriptions, seconded by Pat Knebel. The motion passed unanimously.
- III. Chuck Yung to develop a sign-up form for scouts desiring to run for elected positions.
- IV. Scott Addington will present the job descriptions to the troop at a meeting prior to the elections. Mr Noon suggested the scoutmaster and senior patrol leader review the applicants, and decide the final slate of candidates.
- V. Sign-up sheet to be posted on the 19th, with election the following week. Election to be conducted "top down", starting with SPL Proposal by Scott Addington / Doug Burdette that, if a scout fails to fulfill his obligation, the SM and SPL will intervene, and if necessary a new election will be held to fill his vacated position.
- VI. Participation guidance; as per Lee Roberts suggestions; the degree of participation to be set out for the scouts, describing the expected involvement for troop membership, followed by a greater degree of participation for rank advancement. Scouts in positions of responsibility are expected to have the highest level of participation.
 - There was also discussion as to how much each scout should be involved in each type of activity, with a goal of well-rounded participation. The committee understood and agreed that, with extracurricular activity there would be times when scouts would not be able to participate in some troop activities.
 - Pat Knebel to write a description articulating the expectation of the committee.
- VII. Mr Noon recommended that Junior Leader Training should be conducted at least annually.

 Dawn Dorsch, Pat Knebel and Lee Roberts to form a subcommittee to develop written guidelines for participation.
