

## SCOUTMASTER'S MINUTE



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Well, it's March already and the year is flashing by. Camp Rowe was a cold windy outing. A big snow storm was forecast, but we only had a few flakes. On Friday night we got 2 Frost points. Saturday was the snowy day, but less than half an inch accumulated. Last month we bridged over 3 new Scouts from Pack 87. One of our new Scouts has a peanut allergy so please be mindful of that when making menus or sending snacks to troop events. If something you send contains any peanut products be sure to clearly label it. March 28 we will be Bridging over another new scout from Pack 98. Our final meeting in March will be work on cooking merit badge. Be sure to bring in your filled out workbooks. Our April campout will be on the weekend of April 5 thru 7 at Pawnee Buttes. While there we will try to get some star gazing in for those needing to complete Astronomy merit badge. For April we will be working on Genealogy merit Badge.

Spring Camporee will be "Camp Gadget" May 3-5 at Soaring Eagle, BDSR. Spring Camporee will consist of 4 separate competitions that you will compete in with your Patrols. The events will take place in or near your campsites. District will only be providing judges, so the adults in our Troop will be supervising our Scouts.

Scouts will have 3 hours to construct camp gadgets using materials that you bring with you (and take back home after you are done). You will be judged on originality, creativity, usefulness, and Scouting skills. Gadgets must be constructed on-site (during the 3 hour time period) you may not build them in advance. #### **Committee Reports:**

Finances: Budget discussed, monthly balanced not provided

**Fundraising:** Ft Collins Nursery in April: Bev and Lori will co-chair. They will confirm the date and provide it to the troop, SPL and Pat D.

**New Scouts**: Dawn/Matt will process the new Scout applications (Jonah and Martin).

FOS: We made both our Patch and Camp goals. Thanks to all of you for contributing.

**High Adventure 2014**: The committee agreed that this camp will be in 2015. Mark W. will confirm the Scout choice by the 4/30 Court of Honor.

**Elk's Lodge**: We need an adult to volunteer to be the liaison with the Elk's Lodge. The time commitment is minimal – 2-3 hours a year. If you are interested, please contact Dawn or Mr. Addington.

#### **Old Business:**

- Eagle Scout Plaque: Will discuss in April to ask for volunteer to travel to Greely to research (Maybe Scott A and Doug B) as it would be nice to have this done by the end of May
- Election Recap: The committee members and ASM felt that the election went well given the new position descriptions and format. We will make a couple of adjustment for the next one. Thanks to all the parents/adults that helped to finalize all of these policies.

#### **New Business:**

- Budget Review: Kim presented two budge formats for discussion. The committee asked Kim to create a combined budget using the best of both formats. Kim will create and provide to the committee at the next meeting.
  - Summer Camp Gas Payment: Pat K. motioned that each Scout attending summer camp will prepay a set amount to cover gas expenses two weeks prior to camp. If the amount paid if greater than the actual amount, the difference will be deposited into the Scout's account. If the amount paid is less than the actual amount, the difference will be deducted from the Scout's account or paid promptly by the scout/family. Bev A. seconded.
  - Negative Scout Account balances: Expectation is that all accounts are in the positive or events are paid for before the Scout can participate.
- Gathering/Review of past financial policy: Kim Yung will review the old committee meeting minutes for all policies relating to finances and gather these into one document.
- Training:
