Summer Camp will be here in no time. Final payments are due in to council be 1 May so be sure to see Mr. Addington or Mrs. Yung and get your payments in. We are able to accommodate additional Scouts or adults if someone still wants to attend. A very important item for summer camp is physicals. Every summer camp participant needs a current BSA physical to attend camp. The forms can be downloaded from the Longs Peak Council website. Any camper without a current physical in hand will be sent home from camp on check-in day so please get those physicals done and turned in to Mr. Addington

Finally a note about adult participation. While we strive to have a boy led Troop, we cannot go on campouts without adequate adult supervision. That means two deep adults at a minimum. Parents, please participate when you can. If everyone takes a turn it is not so time consuming. If the same few parents come every time it gets to be a burden. Adults attending summer camp will need to complete or update their Youth Protection Guidelines training to be sure you are current. This can be done online through the Longs Peak Council website. A BSA membership number is not needed for YPG training.

#### Committee Meeting Date: April 9, 2013

#### **Committee Reports:**

**Finances:** Scout Account = 2305.44; Troop Account = 2242.47; Per Scout = 82.34 **Fundraising:** Ft Collins Nursery on April 27 and 28: Bev and Lori will co-chair. The Scouts will assist

customers with carrying items to car plus we will have a Bake Sale. The Co chairs will send an email with additional instructions. Please start Baking!!

New Scouts: Dawn has mailed all 3 Scout apps to Greeley.

**Merit Badge Counselors**: Dawn updated the list per the responses. She mailed the additions to Greeley.

**Re-Charter**: Dawn will provide paper copies as needed plus provided pdf copies. **High Adventure 2014**: Mark W. will confirm the Scout choice by the 4/30 Court of Honor. **Elk's Lodge**: Mr. Dougherty agreed to be the liaison with introductions **Secretary**: Mrs. Discoe agreed to be the secretary.

#### Old Business:

- Eagle Scout Plaque: Will discuss in May to ask for volunteer to travel to Greely to research (Maybe Scott A and Doug B) as it would be nice to have this done by the end of May
- Business Cards/Letterhead: Dawn sent final requirements to Logan and Blake for final draft; once approved, Dawn will ask Blake to distribute letterhead to committee members and Logan to coordinating the printing of business cards.

#### New Business:

- Fundraising: Dawn to email all adults asking if they have any ideas for future fundraising. We are
  in need of new fundraising opportunities for general funds plus the 2015 High Adventure camp.
  For the past few years, the Troop has spent \$1600 and the Elk's Lodge provides us with \$1500.
  We just want to be prepared with other options to provide funds for the Troop and the Scouts.
- Budget Review: Kim presented the updated budget. The committee asked for a couple of nomenclature updates to the budget. Kim will distribute for review before the May committee meeting for final approval.
- Budget Policies: Kim provided an outline of several financial items that needed to be discussed. As a committee, we reviewed each item - motioned and approved several updates plus approved those that did not need changes. Kim and Dawn will finalize the items and send to the Scouts and families in a separate email.
- Split of Fundraising Profits: Pat motioned that if a fundraiser makes \$500 or more, the troop will take 20% of the profits with the rest divided among the Scouts that worked the fundraiser; if a fundraiser makes <\$500, the Troop will take 10% of the profits with the rest divided among the Scouts that worked the fundraiser. Cindy T. approved; passed unanimously.
- Youth Training: Doug Burdette agreed to review the Youth Training program options and present his finding to the committee in May.

- Quartermaster, Cole Beyer: Made three requests for the committee's permission:
  - explore the costs of creating a repair kit for the trailer. The repair kit would contain several items to repair tents and patrol boxes. All tents will be numbered so Scouts can report issues by tent. Robert motioned; Bev seconded; passed unanimously. Once final list and costs are determined, ask the Scoutmaster for final approval.
  - To order additional Class B t-shirts for summer camp. Bev motioned; Robert seconded; passed unanimously. Cole will circulate a new list plus solicit hand me downs.
  - To purge the oils in all the patrol boxes and replace with oil approved by Jonah's parents. Kim motioned; Robert seconded; passed unanimously.
