May 7, 2013

Lawn Mowing – Sean will bring combo lock so that anyone who needs to mow may do so. Mowing will be done on Tuesdays night while we are at meeting on a volunteer basis.

Elks – Sean will be the official liaison for the Troop. What do they need? We need \$.

FISCAL - Balances

Entire Acct. 4,187.97 Troop Acct. 3,481.07 Scout Accts. 706.90

Budget review for next year reveals \$17.25 shortage. Budget approved. Scott motioned, Chuck 2nd, Unanimously approved.

FC Nursery Fundraiser - \$517 total. Doug motioned for Troop to take 10%, Matt 2nd, Unanimously approved.

Fiscal Policy #25 – Kim Y. proposed. Sean motioned. Doug 2nd. Unanimously approved.

Any Scout who commits to attend a campout/event but does not attend shall be responsible for the money spent preparing for his attendance. (e.g. food purchased) This may be reviewed by the Committee on a case by case basis when unusual circumstances are noted.

Fiscal Policy #26 – Kim Y. proposed. Sean motioned. Doug 2nd. Unanimously approved.

In the case of a prepaid event, if a Scout commits to attend but does not, all non-refundable monies will be forfeited. This may be reviewed by the Committee on a case by case basis when unusual circumstances are noted.

Fiscal policies 1-24 – Doug motioned, Sean 2nd, Unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS

Scott proposed to set aside \$ for repair/replacement of camping equipment. Sean proposed that the scribe write a letter to Jax, REI, etc. asking for help with purchases. To be discussed in June.

Sean – proposed looking into groups like Sertoma. Dawn to follow up with a friend who is a member. Scott – proposed silent auction. Troop needs to look for location/event with financially strong supporters. Lori – proposed Scouts make wood items to sell: birdhouses, benches, planters, shelves, chairs.
