#### A. Finance:

- Need to collect Klondike fees from Scouts who attended

    - Pack 197 Doug will check with the WB-II's
  - 2015 High Adventure Camp Update: 2 crews registered, initial payment made to Camp, next Scout payment due is 4/1/14 for \$200. Review the new payment schedule and add to minutes for February.
    - (Original plan was down payment of \$50 and \$200 every 3 months after that)

  - Journey to Excellence is part of recharter every year; 13 categories
  - Scout Strong is a fitness category for scouts (and adults)

  - Different levels to achieve the JTE goals: introduce the program, set goals, hold fitness competitions.
