### Upcoming Fundraisers:

- Horsetooth Swim: August 23 at 7:00 am at the Beach at Horsetooth
- The Scouts will cook pancakes (all supplies and food provided to us at \$0 cost) for the swimmers as they finish their race. We earn money from the tips. We need 3-4 Leaders and 6-8 Scouts. The hours worked by the Scouts can be counted towards their service hours. Scott Addington will be coordinating this fundraiser.
- **Popcorn Sales:** Starting MM, DD MM, DD. Cindy Tunney will be coordinating Popcorn Sales this year.
- Ft Collins Nursery: Labor Day Weekend with the date and times to be provided soon. The Scouts will help Customers load purchases into their cars PLUS we will be cooking hamburgers and selling food. We will work 2 shifts with 3-4 Scouts per shifts/2 adults per shifts. Bev Addington will be coordinating this fundraiser.
- Pancake Breakfast: November 15 at 9:00 am at the Elk's Lodge --- more details to come in September. A Parent Volunteer is needed to coordinate this fundraiser.

We need an adult or two to shadow Scott (Horsetooth Swim) and Bev (Ft. Collins Nursery) at these fundraisers. The Troop does these fundraisers yearly. These will be the last fundraisers that Scott and Bev will be coordinating. Their son, Dylan, has earned his Eagle Scout, aged out of the troop and starting at University of Wyoming in a few weeks. - <u>Additional Court of Honor</u>: We will be adding an additional Court of Honor at the Holiday Party. This will help with our Journey to Excellence reporting for this year.
- <u>Transition of Leadership</u>: In the next few months, Scott Addington will be stepping down as Scout Master. At our September committee meeting, we will discuss the transition of leadership for this very important position plus other key positions within the Troop. Please plan to attend this meeting as it is your opportunity to participate in this important transition.
- <u>Parent Involvement</u>: The Committee discussed ways to involve the parents of the Scouts in troop activities including fundraising, camping, day trips, etc. Dawn will create a list of Roles within the Troop Leadership for the September Committee Meeting.
- <u>Patrol Leader Training</u>: Matt has done some research into the options for offering this training to the Scouts. The program we will be using has 3 (60-90 minute) modules. It is a framework that can be built to fit our troop's culture and values. Matt will purchase or print the materials and present the Training at the September committee Meeting. We are hoping to offer this training in the fall. If you are interested in being a part of the training, please let Matt or Dawn know. By offering yearly patrol leader training, we will complete another Journey to Excellence requirement.
- <u>Troop Activity Book</u>: Matt visited with a couple of the Senior Scouts about what changes/improvements to make within the Troop. The consensus is to create an Activity Book. This book would be full of camping locations, hiking locations, away meeting locations, volunteer/service hour opportunities, meeting activities to fill time if extra time during the meeting is available. Cindy suggested that a template document be designed which could be used for each activity. Anyone would be able to suggest an activity to be included in the book. Robert will ask Mark to develop the template.
