

SCUUTMASTER'S MINUTE



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Hello Troop 87,

Happy New Year! 2015 was an amazing year for the troop. Almost every scout advanced at least one rank, including our newest Eagle Scouts: Chris, Josh, and Dylan! I'm excited about continuing that momentum for the upcoming year. I'm also looking forward to increasing the number and kinds of outdoor activities and away meetings, welcoming a large group of Webelos bridging over in April, and participating in the Eagle projects we're expecting over the next 12 months.

New Rank Requirements: This new year brings with it updated rank requirements for the scouts. The scout badge is moving from being a "joining badge" to a full-fledged rank. With that change, some requirements have been moved around within the Tenderfoot-First Class ranks. Additional fitness and service hour requirements have been added to these ranks as well as a number of other new requirements. I handed out inserts with the requirements for the scouts to add to their handbooks. Scouts should secure these inserts into their handbooks so they don't lose any signoff in them.

2016 will be a transition year for current scouts:

- Current scouts working on Tenderfoot First Class may continue to use the old requirements until reaching First class or Jan 1, 2017, whichever comes first.
- Current scouts who are working on Star, Life, or Eagle may continue to use the current requirements until they complete the current rank they are working on or Jan 1, 2017, whichever comes first.
- New scouts must use the new requirements.

Summer Camp: The scouts have chosen to attend Camp Laramie Peak in Wheatland, WY the week of July 10-14. Cost will be: \$295. \$50 deposit is due at registration. 1/2 balance (\$150) will be due at the January 26th meeting and remainder will be due at the April 26th meeting. We will hopefully be getting a \$45 discount off the total, but won't have that information until April.
