Holiday Party Damage deposit (Elks Lodge): \$200 deposit to cover any potential damages. Refunded after party, as long as there are no damages incurred.

Pancake breakfast: November 18, Saturday 8 am to noon. Scouts just need to sign up and use north door for entry.

Advertising: libraries, Fort Collins Museum, Mr. Birlingmair work and Nelsons Automotive, various committee members to go around town and put up flyers. Please post it on facebook.

Number count: Due 11/15. Elks Lodge will to their members. Pancakes, coffees, sausage, juice, napkins and paper plates provided.

Christmas tree pick-up fundraiser: January 7th, 2018 Sunday afternoon, potentially. Scouts will deliver door hangers shortly after Christmas. Scout will put their names on the envelopes and check their neighborhood for trees. Need to schedule a meeting time to plan. Mr. Grimmer and Mr. Birlingmair have square card readers to process credit card donations.

Round Table: Mr. Birlingmair needs to file volunteering that we do. All new adult leaders/merit badge counselors must take YPT. Training is good for two years, new more detailed training coming soon.

Registration on the trailer: Mr. Grimmer renewed registration, good for one year.

Cindy motioned to approve October committee meeting notes. Mr. Grimmer seconded. All voted to approve the October minutes.

Summer Camp 2018: going to in-council camp next year. Once a camp is chosen, revisit potential weeks for best Scout availability.

Holiday Party: Scouts will have a gift exchange, "robbery style," please bring a gift worth \$10-15 to participate. Troop will provide main dish (Mr. Grimmer) and all are asked to bring a side or dessert. Mr. Grimmer will ask Elks Lodge for water/coffee, also have soda and lemonade upstairs.

Balances

If Scouts choose not to continue, their funds will be rolled into the Troop account. Anticipate deposits for popcorn, pancake breakfast and King Soopers funds. Will likely have a deposit early next year for Xmas trees. Anticipate disbursement for the main dish for the Holiday party.
